#### SPARKLING WINE

##### SNIFE

#### 1. Colle de Principe Frizzante, Prosecco Italy 11 32

Light, gently sparkling Prosecco from Veneto. Crisp apple and floral aromas with a refreshing, dry finish. Perfect as an aperitif or with light dishes. Elegant, easy-drinking, and beautifully balanced.

#### 2. Crémant De Limoux Rosé Grand Cuvée, Limoux France 55

Elegant and dry sparkling rosé made from Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc, and Pinot Noir. Aromas of crushed raspberries, strawberries, and ripe peaches lead to a creamy palate with fine bubbles and refreshing acidity.

#### 3. Pannier Brut NV, Champagne France 95

A wonderfully generous and opulent Champagne with an extended 36 months ageing in bottle! Expect toasty citrus aromas, buttered croissants, and zesty grapefruit. The palate is rounded and nutty with honeyed stone fruit, crisp acidity, and persistent fine bubbles.

#### 4. Veuve Clicquot NV, Champagne France 120

Iconic Champagne with vibrant citrus, apple, and brioche notes. Fine bubbles and a creamy texture deliver elegance and depth. Perfect for celebrations, aperitifs, or pairing with seafood. Consistently refined and luxurious.

#### 5. Dom Perignon, Champagne France 350

The most iconic vintage Champagne with fine mousse, notes of brioche, citrus, almond, and toasted spice. Elegant, complex, and persistent. A celebration in every glass!

#### 6. Gabriella Pinot Grigio Blush, Veneto Italy 8 30

Delicate and refreshing rosé with subtle notes of citrus, white peach, and green apple. Light-bodied and crisp, perfect as an aperitif or paired with charcuterie.

#### 7. Fleur d'Eglantine, Rhône Valley France 37

A classically delicate and elegant southern French rosé with floral aromas, balanced by red berries and a refreshing mineral finish. Crafted from organically grown grapes on a boutique family winery in Costières de Nîmes.

#### 8. Porrais Branco, Douro Valley Portugal 7.50 28

A fresh, expressive blend, reflecting Douro's rugged, highland terroir. It offers crisp citrus, mineral, and floral notes.

#### 9. Saint Marc Réserve Chardonnay, Languedoc France 7.75 30

A classically elegant style of unoaked French Chardonnay from sustainably farmed vineyards. Expect soft orchard fruits over a silky soft palate.

#### 10. Villa Marchesi Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Veneto Italy 8.25 32

Crafted in Friuli, northeast Italy, on a family estate, this is a great expression of Pinot Grigio: dry and crisp, with soft pear, red apple and a touch of almond.

#### 11. Rabbit Island Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 9.25 36

From the pioneering Seifried family in Nelson, this wine is made with certified sustainable grapes. Expect a wonderful wash of ripe tropical fruit flavours.

#### 12. Viña Eguia Albariño, Rías Baixas Spain 10.00 40

A classic Galician Albariño, Viña Eguia is dry, fresh and floral, with plenty of crisp citrus & juicy stone fruit flavours, before a characteristic saline edge on the finish.

#### RED WINE

#### 13. Le Bosq Rouge, Gascony France 7.50 28

A juicy, easy-drinking, food-friendly cuvée. A Grenache-led blend, it is soft and ripe, with strawberry and blackberry fruit, before a peppery complexity on the finish.

#### 14. Cantina Colli Euganei Merlot, Italy 8.00 31

Produced by a collective of grape growers in the Euganean Hills, this Merlot reflects the region's ancient winemaking heritage. Full-bodied, yet classically elegant.

#### 15. Bodegas Muriel Crianza, Rioja Spain 8.75 34

Family-run since 1926, Bodegas Muriel's Crianza is smooth and elegant with sweet cherry, spice and a hint of vanilla on the long, savoury finish.

#### 16. Château Mourgues du Grès, Rhône Valley France 9.50 38

From a certified organic, family-run estate, this Syrah/Grenache blend is worthy of Cru status. Silky and elegant, yet with the robust structure that epitomises top Rhône.

#### 17. La Mascota Malbec, Mendoza Argentina 10.00 40

A family-run winery in Mendoza, this is crafted from sustainable vineyards, nestled in the Andes. The cool mountain breezes and rich alluvial soils create a wonderfully complex wine.

## CELLAR SELECTION

A carefully curated selection of wines from some of the most iconic vineyard sites in Europe, renowned for their consistent exquisite quality.

### WHITE WINE

- 18. Broglia de Meirana Gavi di Gavi, Piedmont Italy** **48** **BTL**  
From a historic, family-run estate in northern Italy, this single vineyard wine is made with sustainably farmed Cortese grapes. Dry, crisp, with a complex citrus, almond & floral notes.
- 19. Domaine Roy Chablis, Chablis France** **54**  
A fifth-generation family-run estate, Domaine Roy farms sustainably on the right bank of the Serein River. Their Chablis reflects the purity of the Kimmeridgian soil, mineral-driven, crisp acidity and refreshing citrus notes.
- 20. Domaine Bizet Sancerre, Sancerre France** **58**  
Crafted by a fourth-generation, family-run boutique winery. The Sauvignon Blanc grapes are carefully chosen from three expressive sites, displaying waves of crunchy green apple, orchard fruit & a clean mineral note on the long finish.
- 21. Domaine Bader Mimeur, Chassagne-Montrachet Burgundy** **120**  
Elegant white Burgundy with layered citrus, white flowers, and subtle oak. Mineral-driven, creamy texture, and a long, satisfying finish. A refined expression of Chardonnay from one of the most iconic vineyard parcels in the Côte de Beaune.

### RED WINE

- 22. Torre Raone Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy** **48**  
A wonderfully rich and velvety, classic Italian red with ripe blackberry, plum, and violet aromas. Soft tannins and balanced acidity deliver a smooth, harmonious finish. Elegant and expressive.
- 23. Álvaro Palacios Camins del Priorat, Priorat Spain** **58**  
Crafted by visionary winemaker, Álvaro Palacios, from organic grapes grown on the iconic llicorella slate soil. Bursting with blackberry, plum, spice, and a mineral backbone, this wonderfully expresses the rugged Priorat terroir.
- 24. Château Puynard The Prestige, Côtes de Blaye Bordeaux** **66**  
This estate is owned by proud Irishman, Andrew Eakin. The estate is farmed organically. Expect a rich, expressive cuvée, showcasing the excellent quality and from this relatively unknown part of Bordeaux's Right Bank.
- 25. Domaine Lucien Boillot, Gevrey Chambertin Burgundy** **135**  
Classic Pinot Noir from a historic domaine. Wonderfully silky tannins are framed by ripe red cherry, earth, and spiced notes. Elegant structure with a concentrated depth of flavour. This is a true reflection of Gevrey's unique terroir and concentration of old-vine Pinot Noir.

## EXPLORER'S SELECTION

### WHITE WINE

- 26. Zahel Grüner Veltliner, Vienna Austria** **39** **BTL**  
Austrian Grüner is one of the most trendy wine styles at the moment and this example shows why: organically grown grapes burst with green apple, melon, citrus, and white pepper. Fresh acidity and floral aromas make it ideal for a variety of foods, or enjoyed solo.
- 27. Torre Raone Pecorino, Abruzzo Italy** **45**  
Certified organic white, from an exciting family winery in Abruzzo. Made from the ancient Pecorino grape variety, flavours of citrus rind, apricot, and herbal notes explode from the glass. Crisp acidity and a saline finish, this is a wonderfully balanced wine.
- 28. Bodegas Huesgen Weissburgunder, Mosel Germany** **49**  
German wine can be misunderstood, so explore this dry, elegant Pinot Blanc from Mosel. Crisp yellow apple, melon, and subtle floral notes. Organically grown grapes with Fair'n Green certification offer a refreshing, food-friendly white with undoubted finesse.

### RED WINE

- 29. Bodegas Valdesil Valderroa Carballo Mencía, Valdeorras Spain** **39**  
Elegant, high-altitude Mencía grapes, chosen from century-old vines in Valdeorras, northeast Spain. Intense black fruit, slate minerality, and silky texture. Aged in oak, showcasing finesse, freshness, and depth. A standout example of extreme Galician viticulture.
- 30. Terre di Tenuta di San Leonardo, Italy** **49**  
From the historic, family-owned Tenuta San Leonardo estate in Trentino, the grapes for this Bordeaux-style blend are grown in the hills over Lake Garda. A wonderfully elegant and complex wine with wild berry, spice & earthy notes.
- 31. Pierre-Marie Chermette, Brouilly France** **59**  
From a traditional family-run estate, this is modern Beaujolais Cru, crafted using Gamay grapes grown on iconic granite soils at the base of Mont Brouilly. Made with minimal intervention, this wine offers vibrant fruit, floral elegance, and silky tannins.
